


Product feed URLs and files

Your customers and channels need your product information, but they need it in all different ways. Each company or system has their own requirements about the format, structure, and naming conventions. This is not only confusing, but it's especially time-consuming because of all the repetitive copy and pasting you have to do.

Plytix Channels offers two solutions: product feed URLs and product feed files. These solutions help you share your product content with your customers and channels, formatted exactly how they want it.




Product Feed URLs

How do they work?

Our platform offers CSV, XLSX, ISON, and XML feeds. This means you'll create the list of products you want to send to your sales channel, and Plytix will generate a link (what we call a feed URL) that contains your product information either in CSV, XLSX, or XML format. Then you paste the link from Plytix into your sales channel account and watch your products update automatically from then on—no need to update the link.

What's the difference between CSV and XML? That just depends on the requirements of your sales channel. We offer both so you can choose whichever one they ask you for.



Product Feed Files How do they work?

When working with marketplaces or directly with a retailer or customer, most of the time you'll need a spreadsheet instead of a URL. That's when you'll want to download your product data as a product feed file.

Plytix makes formatting your product information easy. First you upload a sample CSV template with the requirements of your marketplace or customer. This gives you the required structure for your finished spreadsheet: the order columns should be in, their headers, how the data should be formatted, and more. From there you map, or match, their requirements with your product information in Plytix. Now your spreadsheet is ready for download!


